### **Meningitis Vaccination Notification**

In addition to completing the application for readmission, the on-campus housing application (if you need it), and registering for classes, there is an <u>additional step</u> you must complete in order to return to TLU. Texas state law requires all students attending an institution of higher education to be <u>immunized against bacterial meningitis</u>. According to the law, all students must be immunized or receive a booster shot during the five-year period preceding their enrollment and at least 10 days prior to the start of the term.

#### Evidence of vaccination can include any of the following:

- The signature or stamp of a physician or his/her designee, or public health personnel on a form which shows the month, day, and year the vaccination dose or booster was administered; or
- An official immunization record generated from a state or local health authority; or
- An official record received from school officials, including a record from another state

#### You are exempt from the new law if:

- You are 22 years of age or older; or
- Your physician signs an affidavit which states that the vaccination would be injurious to your health or well-being; or
- You complete the Texas Department of State Health Services conscientious exemption form
